Contest Rules:

1. Entries must be printed legibly or typed.
2. Entries must be original stories created and written by a student in Kindergarten through 6th grade.
3. Stories will be judged in part on creativity, structure and correct spelling and grammar.
4. One winner from each grade level category will be chosen.
K-2nd grades 3rd – 4th grades 5th – 6th grades
5. Entry should not have the writer's name on it. This entry form should be attached to the story. Entry forms and stories will be numbered so that judging is done anonymously. Entries without a completed entry form will be discarded.
6. All entries must be turned in to the Waunakee Public Library by 5 p.m. on Friday, October 9, 2010. No late entries or group entries will be considered in the judging.
7. Winners will be notified by Wednesday, October 13. Winning entries from K-4th grades will be read or told at the Scary Story Afterschool Adventure program on Thursday, October 14, 2010. The top winner in each category will be published on our website.
8. All entries will be displayed at the Waunakee Public Library through November 5, 2010.
9. If you want your story returned to you, it must be picked up at the library by November 15, 2010. All entries left at the library after November 15 will be discarded. Please keep a copy of your story for yourself, just in case!
